## PROJECTS FOR TRAINING / COACHING MEMBERS

The coaching project is a new formula introduced this year to allow a better dissemination of projects' results carried out since the establishment of CONSOREM. It is a day-long training session presented in the offices of our members. The programming of this continuing education is based on the specific interests of a company in terms of a particular material or territory. Nine members (eight companies and the Ministry of Energy and Natural Resources) were visited between the months of June 2014 and January 2015, with a total of 74 geologists participating in the meetings. Twenty-six projects were presented, as well as two intensive courses, two mine visits, and four training sessions involved in the use of the LithoModeleur software that processes lithogeochemical data (Table 1).
